Of course, you have full permission to use the map. I created it using a Wikimedia map file and the data from the Wikipedia English-language page on copyright terms. I wasn't aware until two weeks ago that the map had been added to Wikipedia; but, it was created under a Creative Commons license and is fully usable. The only "exception" I would note is that there are some dates in the map key that don't make sense (the file was originally for Public Domain Day, 1 Jan 2011 and used by COMMUNIA).

FYI, I had been hoping to get the time to upload the SVG version of the map to Wikipedia, but work duties have precluded that so far.
