Achievements

- 2008 Discussions started
- 2009 First file server donated and installed
- 2010 Wikipedia DE "Wissenswert" Contest: We won and got the laser turntable
- 2011 A collector joins and donates 30 000 records
- 2012 Public announcement of the Swiss Foundation Public Domain

Facts

- 50 000 physical records in our collection
 - 9000 unique visits per month
 - 600 digitized audio records
 - 50 m² archive space
 - 6 active people
 - 0 Funding (still)


Nobody to ask, just use it!

Legally, what does free mean?

- Free as in freedom
- A work (Image, Score, Record etc.) is free when it is in the *Public Domain*
 - Legally the term public domain is the opposite of copyright protected
 - Copyright protection is time limited everywhere

In German the legal term is gemeinfrei

Digitizing Process



Cleaning

- Very important step
 - Improves recording, reduces clicks





Dry cleaning (Carbon brush)

Wet cleaning (L'art du Son)

Rinsing (Distilled Water)

Change to clean slipmat

Repeat with back side







Digitizing

- Recording in 24 bit/192 kHz
- Lossless, license and patent free file format:
 - FLAC




Laser turntable

The Needle vs. The Laser



- 1. Scratch damage on the land area of grooves.
- 2. Laser beams that read the audio modulations.
- 3. The area of the groove that is read avoids the scratch.
- 4. The area of the groove where stylus damage is found.
- 5. The groove with damage from a needle.

Investigation of copyright status

- Most time consuming task of all:
 - A lot of information is missing on the records and on the Internet
 - Also there is seldom a release date!
 - You have to get information about:
 - Author(s)/Composer(s)
 - Lyricist(s)
 - Music arranger(s), Conductor(s) and Performer(s)
